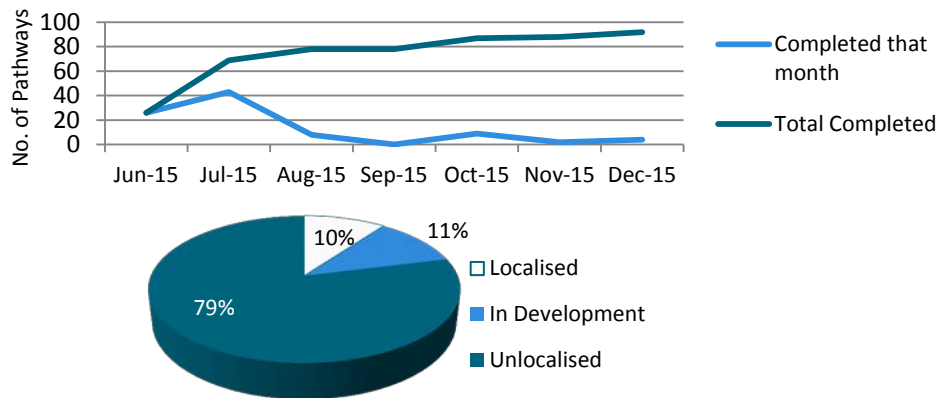

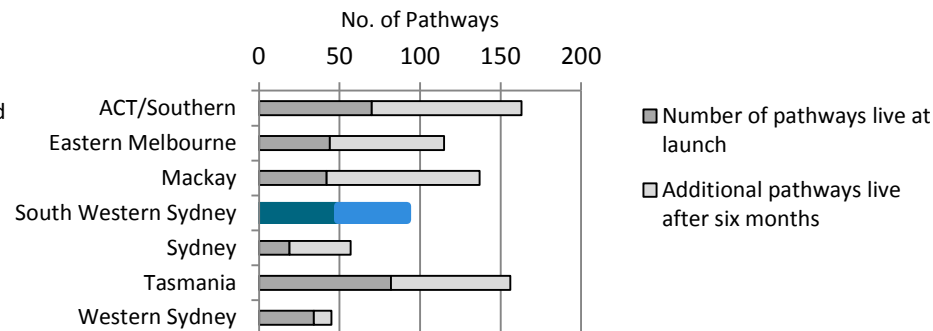

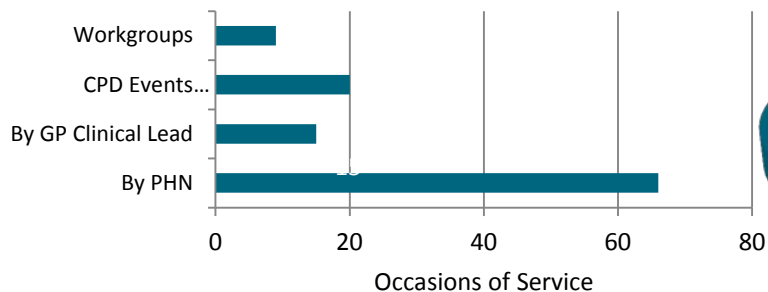
Pathway Development Progress



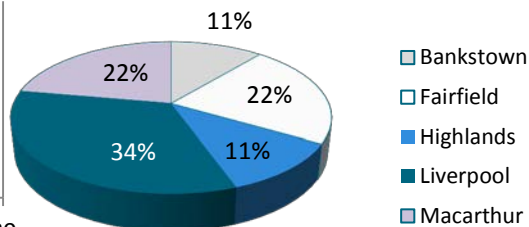
SWS Benchmarking to Comparable Sites



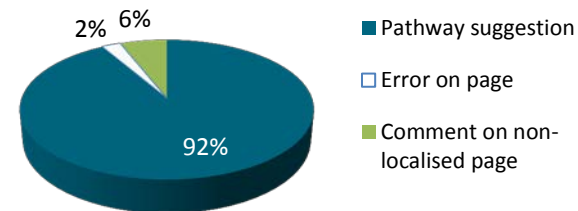

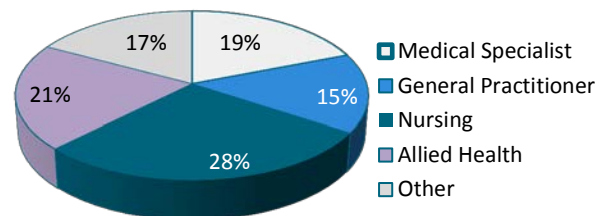

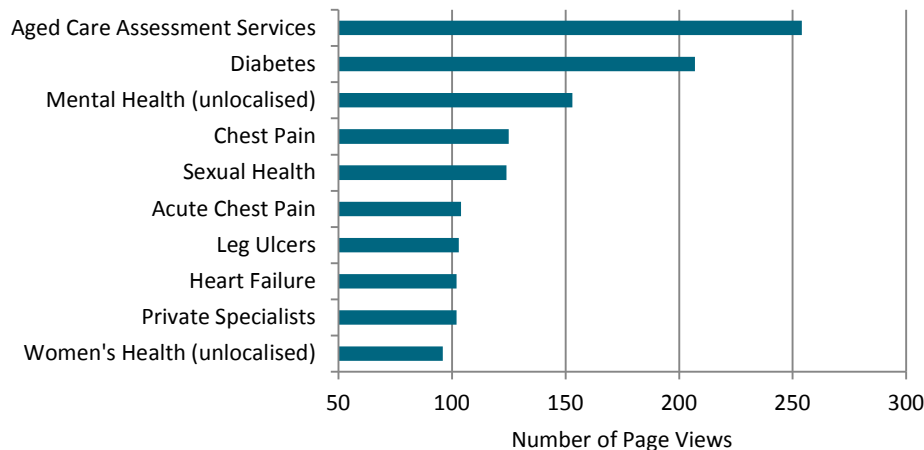
