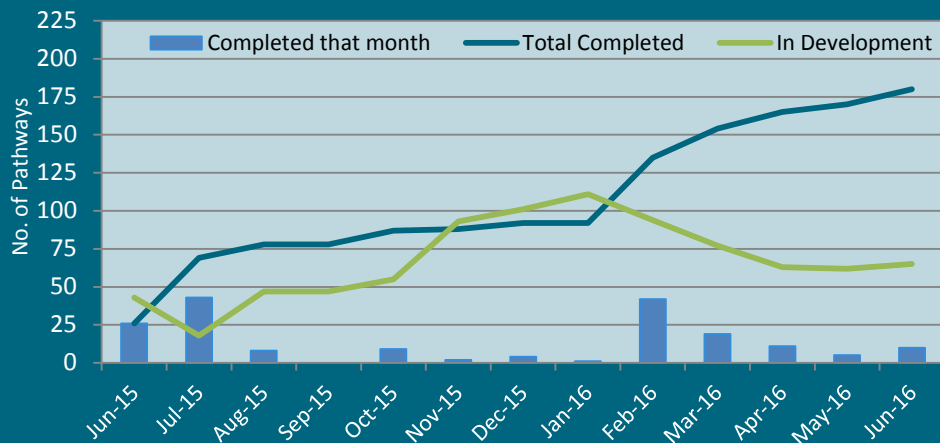

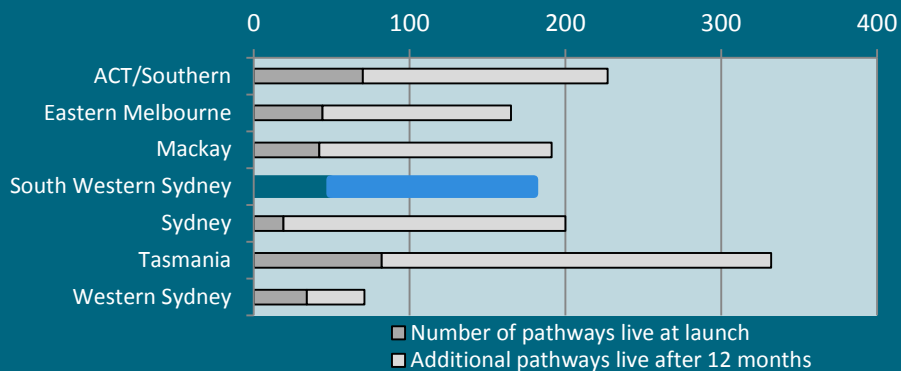

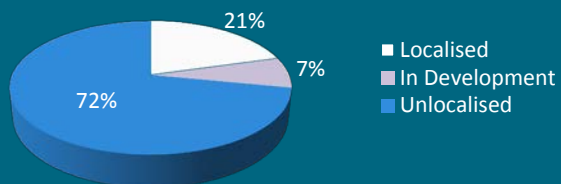
Pathway Development Progress



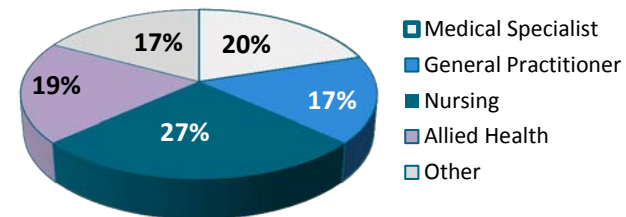
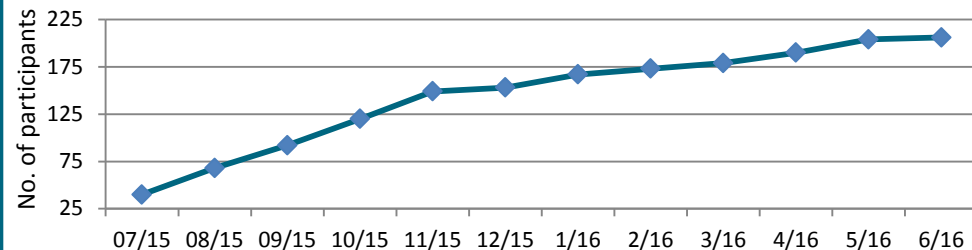
SWS Benchmarking to Comparable Sites



Pathway Status



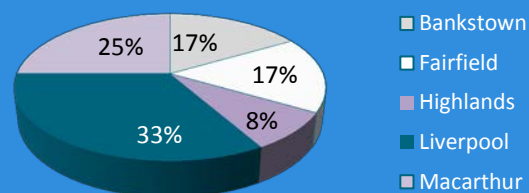

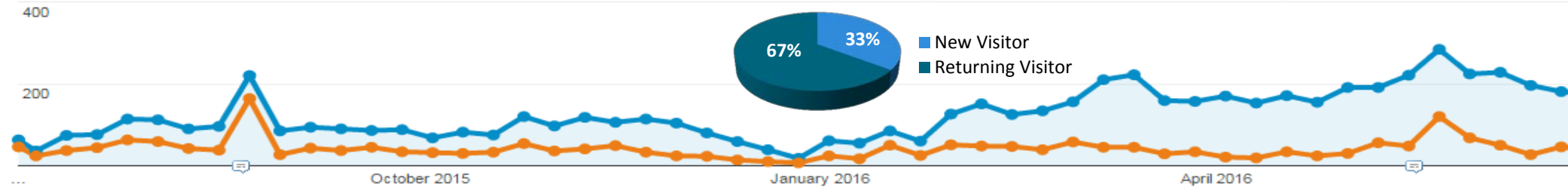

Google Analytics Audience Overview (1 July, 2015 – 30 June, 2016)

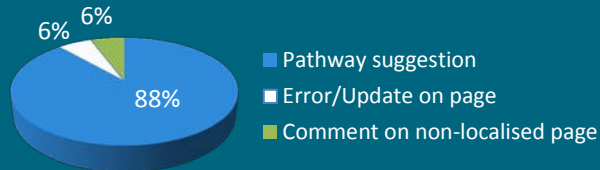

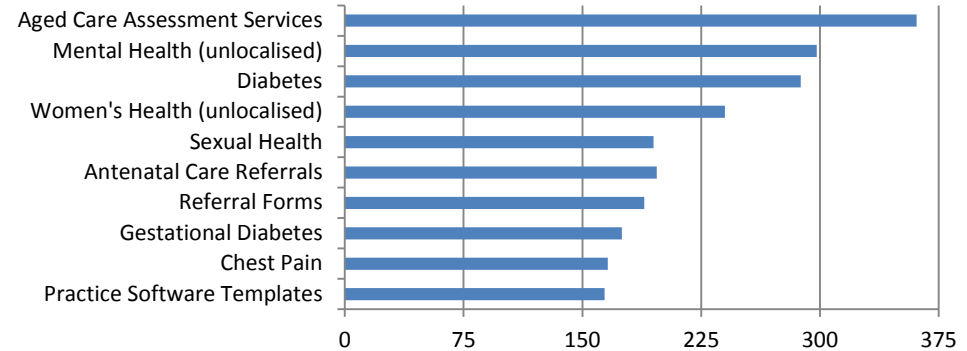

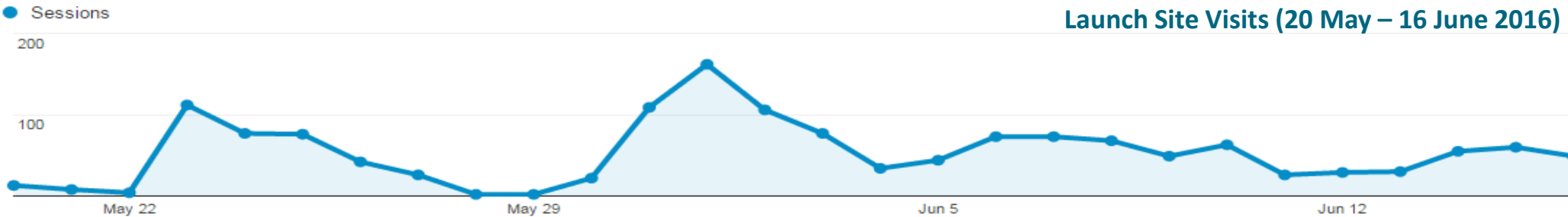
